Eligibility Requirements:

Opening Number: Skating Club of Amherst home club members who are eligible for a 2012 show solo or trio.

Solo: Skating Club of Amherst home club members qualify for a solo after earning a minimum of 85 points from testing and/or competing between Sept. 1 and Aug. 31 of a previous year. Once qualified, soloists must maintain their eligibility each year by skating a minimum of **two days per week**, with a minimum of **three freestyle** sessions during the fall, winter, and spring seasons. Moves-in-the-field sessions do not count toward meeting the requirement.

The music length allowed is:

Pre-Preliminary	1.5 minutes	Intermediate	2.0 minutes
Preliminary	1.5 minutes	Novice	2.5 minutes
Pre-Juvenile	1.5 minutes	Junior	2.5 minutes
Juvenile	2.0 minutes	Senior	3.0 minutes

Trio: Skating Club of Amherst home club members qualify for a trio by passing the trio tryout. Once qualified, trio skaters must maintain their eligibility each year by skating a minimum of **two days per week**, during the fall, winter, and spring seasons. The Learn-to-Skate program and moves-in-the-field sessions do not count toward meeting this requirement. Each trio is responsible for selecting their own coach, music, and costume. Music and costumes are subject to approval by the coaches and/or the costume committee. Music length allowed is 1.5 minutes.

Intermediate Group: Skating Club of Amherst home club members who qualify for a 2012 show trio and who have met the trio requirements listed above.

Advanced Group: Skating Club of Amherst home club members who qualify for a 2012 show solo and who have met the soloist requirements listed above.

Show Group: Skating Club of Amherst home club members who either skate two sessions a week during the winter season (November – March) or Skating Club of Amherst home club members who skate at least one freestyle session during the fall, winter, and spring seasons. **Note: The Sunday Learn-to-Skate Program can be counted as one of your two winter sessions.**

Costumes: No boas, feathers, loose beads, etc. are allowed. **A skating dress may be used for a base but it must look like a costume that is appropriate to the music rather than a skating dress.** The costume can be made in a way that it can be used as a practice dress after the show by doing a few alterations.

Please remember: Music and Costumes are on a first-come-first-served basis and are subject to approval by the coaches and/or the costume committee.
