INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING ONLINE THROUGH ENTRYEEZE:

1. Go to the skating club website at www.scamherst.org and click on the link found on the home page for registering online.
2. Enter the Entryeeze site by clicking on the “Skaters and Parents” button.
3. To register your skater, you will need to provide your skater’s U.S. Figure Skating number. You will need to create a separate account for each skater you are registering. If you do not know your skater’s USFS number, please e-mail Rita Leaman at info@scamherst.org or call Rita at 413-256-6744 and she will provide you with the number.
4. You will receive a pin number for each account. It is important to keep this number. When the competition schedule becomes available, you will need to provide this pin number to access your entryeeze accounts in order to view your skater’s individual event schedule.
5. Next, fill in the skater’s personal information (name, address, phone, e-mail, etc.).
6. Next, you will be asked to select a home club. Begin by typing in “sc of amherst” and “SC of Amherst (MA)” will pop up. This is your correct home club selection.
7. Then you will need to select a coach. If you do not have a private lesson coach, please type in the program director’s name, “Nancy Asai”. However, if you do have a private lesson coach, please type in her name and then select her name from the list that pops up. If your coach’s name does not appear, try typing in their last name first.
8. The Entry Information section comes next. This is the section where you register your skater for their competition events. Your skater can either register for the level they are currently working on *OR* for the level they have most recently passed. However, if you do not know your skater’s level or the events for which they are eligible, you can get this information from your skater’s private lesson coach or from Nancy Asai.
