SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 18: 10 AM – 2:00 PM -- THE SKATING CLUB WILL HOST A BASIC SKILLS COMPETITION AT THE MULLINS CENTER. THERE WILL BE EVENTS IN ALL BASIC SKILLS AND FREESKATE LEVELS AS WELL AS BEGINNER AND HIGH BEGINNER EVENTS. PLEASE ENCOURAGE YOUR SKATER TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS LOW-LEVEL, FUN COMPETITION. ALL SKATERS RECEIVE A SC OF AMHERST MEDAL.

The Fall 2018 ice sessions begin on Tuesday, September 4, and end on Wednesday, October 30. All sessions will be at the Mullins Center in Amherst, MA. *Please note that there is no skating on the following dates: Sunday, September 16, Friday, September 28, Friday, October 12, and Sunday, October 21.*

POWER STROKING CLASS: The skating club offers a Power Stroking class on Sundays from 4:30 – 5:00 pm. If you are interested in registering for power stroking, please check the space on the ice registration form.

SESSION MONITORS: The SC of Amherst is a volunteer organization. Volunteers are needed to monitor each club session (monitors check in the skaters, process guest fees, play music tapes, and generally oversee the session). No experience is needed. Someone will help you get started. Please help by volunteering to monitor your skater's session and indicate your session preference on the ice registration form

ICE SHOW 2019: Sunday, March 24, 2019, is the club's annual ice show. Please note that commitment to the ice show will also require some attendance at the full dress rehearsal on Saturday, March 23. Information on the show will be forthcoming and all club members will be fully informed.

ICE SHOW REQUIREMENTS: The ice session requirements for soloists and trios are as follows: Soloists need to register for a minimum of two days of ice per week with a minimum of three sessions during the Fall, Winter, and Spring seasons. Trio skaters need to register for two days of ice per week during the Fall, Winter, and Spring seasons. Trio tryouts are held each year in October for those needing to qualify for a trio. The Learn-to-Skate Program, Moves in the Field sessions, or the Power Stroking Class do not count toward meeting these soloist or trio requirements.
