

## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR SPRING 2026 LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAM**

**PLEASE NOTE: Pre-Registration is required. No forms or payment will be accepted at the rink. Figure Skates are required. NO hockey skates are allowed.**

The Spring Learn-to-Skate session begins on Sunday, April 19 and continues through Sunday, June 14.

**Please Note the following "NO SKATING" dates on your calendar: Sunday, May 17 & Sunday, May 24**

The registration form is below. After looking over the information, if you decide to register yourself and/or your skater(s), please print out and complete a separate registration form for each skater.

### **SESSION ONE: 7 SUNDAYS 5:40 – 6:15 PM**

For children under 13 on Badges 1, 2, 3, and 4 and for those registered adults who have children registered in Session One. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

### **SESSION TWO: 7 SUNDAYS 6:25 – 7:00 PM**

For adults over 16, young adults 13-16, skaters in Badges 5 and up; and those registered adults who have children registered in Session Two. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

**PLEASE NOTE:** Please read the above session information and register for the session time that matches you or your skater's level or age. If you are unsure of your past level, please email program director, Renee Mayer at [renee.mayer33@gmail.com](mailto:renee.mayer33@gmail.com) However, if the club determines that a skater is in the incorrect session, they will be notified of the change.
