

## HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAM AND REGISTRATION FORM

**PLEASE NOTE: Pre-Registration is required for this program.**

**Absolutely NO registration or membership forms or payment will be accepted at the rink.**

The 10-week January-March Learn-to-Skate Group Lesson Program will begin on Sunday, January 15, and continue through Sunday, March 19, 2023. The program will offer two separate sessions.

There will be no ice sessions on Sunday, March 26, which is the date of the skating club ice show.

### **SESSION ONE: 10 SUNDAYS 5:45 – 6:20 PM**

For skaters on Badges 1, 2, 3, and 4 and for those adults with children registered in Session One.  
25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

### **SESSION TWO: 10 SUNDAYS 6:30 – 7:05**

For all adults over 16 (including those adults with children registered in Session Two); young adults ages 13-16; and skaters in Badge level 5 and higher. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

**PLEASE NOTE: Please read the above session information and register for the session that matches your level/age. For those skaters enrolled in the November 2022 program and who are unsure of their level, please ask the program director, Nancy Asai, at the rink on Sundays or email Nancy at [nea20@comcast.net](mailto:nea20@comcast.net). However, if the club determines that a skater is in the incorrect session, they will be notified of the change.**

### **GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION**

All forms necessary for registering are attached to your email. Forms can also be printed off the club website [www.scamherst.org](http://www.scamherst.org) Registration deadline is Friday, January 13, or until the program is fully subscribed. I am advising you to register early -- registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. No one, current members or new members, are guaranteed a spot. Registrations received after January 13 will be accepted if space allows and with a later starting date. There will be a \$20 late fee.

After looking over the information, if you decide to register your skater(s) for this program, please print out and complete a separate registration form for each skater. **If a membership form has been attached to your email, please print out a membership form and add the appropriate amount to your total ice balance.** The membership fee is a required yearly fee and will remain in effect through June 2023.

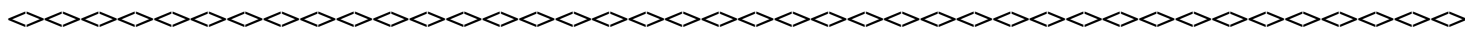

Registration in the Sunday Learn-to-Skate program is encouraged but not required. Registration for this session is recommended for skaters who have passed Basic Skills level 3 or higher.
