

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR FEBRUARY-MID-APRIL 2026 LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAM

PLEASE NOTE: Pre-Registration is required. No forms or payment will be accepted at the rink.
Figure Skates are required. NO hockey skates are allowed.

The second winter Learn-to-Skate session begins on Sunday, February 1 and continues through Sunday, March 29.
Please Note the following “NO SKATING” dates on your calendar: Sunday, April 5 & Sunday, April 12

The registration form is below. After looking over the information, if you decide to register yourself and/or your skater(s), please print out and complete a separate registration form for each skater.

SESSION ONE: 9 SUNDAYS 5:40 – 6:15 PM

For children under 13 on Badges 1, 2, 3, and 4 and for those adults who have children registered in Session One.
25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

SESSION TWO: 9 SUNDAYS 6:25 – 7:00 PM

For adults over 16, young adults 13-16, skaters in Badges 5 and up; and those adults who have children registered in Session Two. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

PLEASE NOTE: Please read the above session information and register for the session time that matches you or your skater's level or age. If you are unsure of your past level, please email program director, Renee Mayer at renee.mayer33@gmail.com However, if the club determines that a skater is in the incorrect session, they will be notified of the change.

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

Club memberships expired on June 30, 2025. Members who have not yet renewed their 2026 membership, please submit a 2025-2026 membership form and add the appropriate membership fee to your total ice balance. It is an insurance requirement that all skaters must be club members.

Registration deadline is Wednesday, January 28. Registrations received after January 28 will be accepted if space is available with a \$20 late fee and possibly a later starting date.

You will receive a confirmation sheet once your registration has been processed. It is recommended that you have this confirmation with you when you come to skate. This will ensure your eligibility to get on the ice.
