COVID-19 MESSAGE: The following list of skating club policies are general policies that have previously been in effect for our club ice sessions. It is not known at this time whether any of these policies will need to be adjusted to meet existing Covid-19 Massachusetts guidelines and restrictions. All club members will be kept informed of any policy updates and all members will be expected to adhere to all changes.

Skating Club of Amherst Policies and Rules of Conduct

The rules of conduct listed below have been established by the Skating Club of Amherst to ensure the safety of all skaters. These rules will be strictly enforced by the ice session monitors, the coaches, and the Board of Directors. However, these rules not all-inclusive. If, at any time, a coach, Board member, or ice monitor sees something that they deem is an unsafe situation, they have a right and a responsibility to ask that person to stop the activity. A failure to adhere to the request may result in the person being asked to leave the ice for the remainder of the session without refund. A serious violation may be referred to the Board of Directors for further action.

Upon receipt and acceptance of club membership, it is understood and agreed that you will abide by the SC of Amherst Policies and Code of Conduct.

PLEASE NOTE: The hockey team boxes are designated as “Skaters and Coaches Only”. Skate bags should be left in the locker rooms. However, if you have something of value, you may leave it in the team box. This policy does **not** apply to the Learn-to-Skate program.

THE FOLLOWING IS EXPECTED:

1. All skaters and professionals will extend the right-of-way to a skater doing a program. The skater doing his/her program will do so with caution. A person in an established spin takes precedence over a person on program.
2. Skaters or coaches should not monopolize any one area of the ice (ex. one of the circles or lines). Please keep the rink corners clear as they are frequently used for jumps. Spinning should be done in the center of the ice.
3. All skaters are required to wear a vest while skating their program.
4. The skating of Intermediate, Novice, Junior, and Senior Moves is not allowed on any Open Freestyle session. The skating of Pre-Silver or higher ice dance is not allowed on any Open Freestyle session.
5. Experienced skaters should set an example for the newer skaters.
6. Clear the ice immediately when it is announced.

THE FOLLOWING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AT ANY TIME:

1. NO skating while wearing headphones or while holding electronic devices (ex. Cell phones, iPods).
2. NO kicking the ice or the boards.
3. NO swearing.
4. NO stomping on the ice.
5. NO eating, drinking, or chewing gum is allowed on the ice.
6. ONLY water bottles are allowed on the boards (No coffee, purses, cell phones, iPods, etc.)
7. NO unsportsmanlike behavior on the ice (for ex. name calling or making negative comments about another skater)
8. NO standing and socializing along the boards..
9. NO pair skating or synchronized skating on a freestyle session.
