

HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAM AND REGISTRATION FORM

PLEASE NOTE: Pre-Registration is required for this program.

Absolutely NO registration or membership forms or payment will be accepted at the rink.

The 7-week November Learn-to-Skate Group Lesson Program will begin on Sunday, November 13, and continue through Sunday, January 8, 2023. The program will offer two separate sessions.

There will be no skating on Sunday, December 25, or on Sunday, January 1.

SESSION ONE: 7 SUNDAYS 5:40 – 6:15 PM

For skaters on Badges 1, 2, 3, and 4 and for those adults with children registered in Session One.

25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

SESSION TWO: 7 SUNDAYS 6:25 – 7:00

For all adults over 16 (including those adults with children registered in Session Two); young adults ages 13-16; and skaters in Badge level 5 and higher. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

PLEASE NOTE: Please read the above session information and register for the session that matches your level/age. For those skaters enrolled in the September 2022 program and who are unsure of their level, please ask the program director, Nancy Asai, at the rink on Sundays or email Nancy at nea20@comcast.net. However, if the club determines that a skater is in the incorrect session, they will be notified of the change.

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

All forms necessary for registering were attached to your email. Forms can also be printed off the club website www.scamherst.org Registration deadline is Friday, November 11, or until the program is fully subscribed. I am advising you to register early -- registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. No one, current members or new members, are guaranteed a spot. Registrations received after November 11 will be accepted if space allows and with a later starting date. There will be a \$20 late fee. **Skaters who register for both the November and January -March Learn-to-Skate sessions will be eligible for a Learn-to-Skate group number in the 2023 ice show.**

After looking over the information, if you decide to register your skater(s) for this program, please print out and complete a separate registration form for each skater. **If a membership form has been attached to your email, please print out a membership form and add the appropriate amount to your total ice balance.** The membership fee is a required yearly fee and will remain in effect through June 2023. Checks or money orders should be made payable to the SC of Amherst. Do not mail cash. If paying with cash, please contact us to arrange for payment.

Looking for additional practice time? The club offers a half-hour practice ice session on Wednesdays from 6-6:30 pm. This session will provide adults and Learn-to-Skate level skaters an additional opportunity to practice the skills they are learning either in the Sunday Learn-to-Skate program or through private coaching. Registration in the Sunday Learn-to-Skate program is encouraged but not required. Registration for this session is recommended for skaters who have passed Basic Skills level 3 or higher since the session fee does not include a lesson. However, if interested in a lesson, a private lesson can be arranged at an additional cost.
