

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR NOVEMBER 2023 LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAM

PLEASE NOTE: Pre-Registration is required for this program.

NO registration or membership forms or payment will be accepted at the rink.

The 8-week Sunday, November 12 through Sunday, January 14 Learn-to-Skate Group Lesson Program will offer two separate sessions. There will be NO SKATING on Sundays, December 24 and December 31.

SESSION ONE: 8 SUNDAYS 5:40 – 6:15 PM

For children under 13 on Badges 1, 2, 3, and 4 and for those adults who have children registered in Session One. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

SESSION TWO: 8 SUNDAYS 6:25 – 7:00 PM

For adults over 16, young adults ages 13-16, skaters in Badges 5 and up, and those adults who have children registered in Session Two.

25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

PLEASE NOTE: Please read the above session information and register for the session that correctly matches your level or age. If you are unsure of your past level, please email program director, Nancy Asai, at nea20@comcast.net. However, if the club determines that a skater is in the incorrect session, the club reserves the right to place the skater in the correct session.

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

The cost for this upcoming 8-week November through Mid-January session is \$142 per skater (plus a membership fee for those who have not paid a membership fee since July 2023). The membership fee is a required annual fee and will remain in effect through June 2024.

The registration information is attached to your email. After looking over the information, if you decide to register your skater(s) for this program, please print out and complete a separate registration form for each skater and, if necessary, one membership form. Checks or money orders should be made payable to the SC of Amherst. Do not mail cash. If paying with cash, please contact us to arrange for payment.

Registration deadline is Friday, November 10, in order to begin on Sunday, November 12. I am advising you to register early -- the demand for this program is overwhelming and registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. No one, current members or new members, is guaranteed a spot. Registrations received after November 10 will be accepted if space allows and with a later starting date. There will be a \$20 late fee.
