

REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR THE LEARN-TO-SKATE PROGRAM

PLEASE NOTE: Pre-Registration is required for this program.

Absolutely NO registration or membership forms or payment will be accepted at the rink.

This 8-week April to June Learn-to-Skate Group Lesson Program will begin on Sunday, April 2, and continue through Sunday, June 4, 2023. The program will offer two separate sessions.

There will be NO SKATING on Sunday, April 9, on Sunday, May 28, and on Monday, May 29.

Please note the slight change in the Sunday session times.

**** There is only two weeks before the start of this Learn-to-Skate program. Please register quickly to guarantee enrollment in this program.**

SESSION ONE: 8 SUNDAYS 5:40 – 6:15 PM

For skaters on Badges 1, 2, 3, and 4 and for those adults with children registered in Session One.

25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

SESSION TWO: 8 SUNDAYS 6:25 – 7:00 PM

For all adults over 16 (including those adults with children registered in Session Two); young adults ages 13-16; and skaters in Badge level 5 and higher. 25-minute lesson - 10 minutes of practice time

PLEASE NOTE: After reading the above session information, please register for the session that matches your level/age. Skaters enrolled in the January 2023 program: if you are unsure of your level, please see the program director, Nancy Asai, at the rink on Sundays or email Nancy at nea20@comcast.net. However, if the club determines that a skater is in the incorrect session, they will be notified of the change.

All forms necessary for registering have been attached to your email. Forms can also be printed off the club website www.scamherst.org Registration deadline is Friday, March 31, or until the program is fully subscribed. Registrations received after March 31 will be accepted if space allows and with a later starting date. There will be a \$20 late fee.

After looking over the information, if you decide to register your skater(s) for this program, please submit a separate registration form for each skater. **If a membership form has been attached to your email, please also submit a membership form and add the appropriate amount to your total ice balance.** The membership fee is a required yearly fee and will remain in effect through June 2023.
